- Mission. Establish an observation post and provide security for IMPRESSIVE DELTA radio relay site on Truci Mountain (vic YC944966) and conduct surveillance operations within your assigned HAVEN to detect possible VC/NVA troop movement or arms infiltration in the Ben Tau area. Particular emphasis is to be placed on surveillance to observe possible rocket launching sites, mortar positions, storage areas, fortifications, and routes of access and egress. Emphasis is also to be placed on establishing a suitable HLZ and adjust arty/air on targets of opportunity in support of Operation Houston.

Coordinating Instructions

- (2) Ensure thorough coordination with the 5thMarRegt who have been assigned the mission of providing the Bald Eagle capability. Special emphasis is to be placed on "link-up" procedures in the event it becomes necessary to employ the BaldEagle.
- (3) Coordinate with SPILLWAY 6 to ensure that you have knowledge of all previously plotted "on call" and any early warning devices that are in place outside the defensive positions.
- (4) Coordinate with any patrol that leaves from your position to ensure safe passage and return through the perimeter degenses.


